- 1. Medium size sketchbook, approximately 9" x 12" or 9" x 6". Bristol pad or all-media paper preferred. Examples: Moleskine Watercolor Album Sketchbook (5" x 8.25"); Holbein 33 Series Pad; Mixed Media Sketch Pad (9"x12").
- 2. View Catcher View finding Tool (Amazon.com)
- 3. Pencils: 2H, F, 4B, Ebony and pencil sharpener
- 4. Kneaded eraser and Mars eraser
- 5. Stabilo Pencils (all-surface or aquarellable). Suggested colors: graphite, black, blue, brown, green, orange, red, white. Other color pencil brands are also acceptable.
- 6. Small container for water
- 7. Brush with water reservoir or watercolor brushes. Examples: Yasutomo Niji Waterbrush set or Pentel Art Aquash Water Brush.
- 8. Folding plastic watercolor palette, 8"x 8" opened or other brand
- 9. Watercolor tubes or cakes: Lemon Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Alizarin Crimson,
 Olive Green, Oxide of Chromium, Permanent Magenta, Phthalo Blue, Burnt Sienna, Ivory
 Black, An alternative is the Winsor & Newton Cotman Watercolor Paint Set.
- 10. Designer Gouache tube: Titanium White
- 11. CVS Sensitive Skin Gentle Paper Tape or Artist Tape Pro-Low Tack
- 12. Paper towels and rags for cleaning up
- 13. Tripod Folding Stool (Amazon) or Folding Step Stool. Folding easel is optional.
